

State Legislation

January 29, 2007 – First Report

The 2007 session begins in a few days and the Retirement System continues to monitor the Bill Draft Request (BDR) list for bills that may affect the Retirement System. As of the date of this posting, no pre-filed bills, for which the full text is available, directly impact the Retirement System. The following is a listing of bills that by description appear to affect the Retirement System.

- ◆ ***BDR #80 – Requested by Senator Lee*** – Revises provisions relating to municipal judges.
- ◆ ***BDR #90 – Requested by Assemblyman Hettrick*** – Provides funding for judges' pension plan.
- ◆ ***BDR #160 – Requested by Assemblywoman McClain*** – Makes various changes concerning Public Employees' Retirement System.
- ◆ ***BDR #281 – Requested by the Public Employees' Retirement System*** – Makes various changes concerning the Public Employees' Retirement System. (System sponsored technical legislation.)
- ◆ ***BDR #327 – Requested by the Nevada Sheriff's and Chief's Association*** – Revises provisions governing retirement compensation of elected officers to credit prior PERS service.
- ◆ ***BDR #466 – Requested by Senator Carlton*** – Revises provisions governing the Public Employees' Retirement System.
- ◆ ***BDR #823 – Requested by Assemblyman Settlemeyer*** – Makes various changes concerning the Public Employees' Retirement System.
- ◆ ***BDR #825 – Requested by Assemblyman Settlemeyer*** – Makes various changes concerning public benefits.
- ◆ ***BDR #976 – Requested by Senator Matthews*** – Expands peace officers who are eligible for early retirement.
- ◆ ***BDR #1074 – Requested by Senate Minority Leader*** – Revises provisions governing the Public Employees' Retirement System.
