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Retiree Benefit Recalculation Form Reemployed Five or More Years

As a retiree reemployed in a PERS eligible position for five or more years, you have two benefit recalculation methods provided by PERS statute. Do not make your selection until you have received benefit estimates from PERS based on both methods of recalculation. You must complete and submit a new retirement application to PERS regardless of which method you choose. If your benefit has been suspended during your reemployment, it is your responsibility to update your deduction and direct deposit information (if applicable) with PERS.
