After discussion, on motion of Todd Ingalsbee, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to accept the Actuarial Valuation and review for the Judicial Retirement System as of June 30, 2023, as prepared by Segal.
- 4.3 Brad Ramirez of Segal reviewed the results of the 2023 Actuarial Valuation Report for the Legislators' Retirement System. On motion of Todd Ingalsbee, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to accept the Actuarial Valuation and review for the Legislators' Retirement System as of June 30, 2023, as prepared by Segal.
- 4.4 On motion of Dawn Huckaby, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to approve the Amendment to the Wells Fargo Master Services Agreement, as submitted.
- 4.5 On motion of Todd Ingalsbee, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the Retirement Board Education Session and Retirement Board meeting held October 25, 2023, as submitted.
- 4.6 On motion of Mark Stevens, the Retirement Board voted unanimously to approve the proposed Retirement Board meeting dates for July 2024 through December 2024, as submitted.
