Re: Nominations for Appointment to the Police and
Firefighter's Retirement Fund Advisory Committee

The Retirement Board is seeking nominations to fill to positions on the Police and Firefighter's Retirement Fund Advisory Committee (Committee). One position is for police management and the other is for a firefighter representative. The appointment of Dean Molburg expires on June 30, 2007. Chief Molburg is not eligible for reappointment. The appointment of Bill Loncar expires on June 30, 2007. Mr. Loncar is eligible for reappointment.

The Committee was established by NRS 586.227 in 1977, for the purpose of making recommendations to the Retirement Board on all matters pertaining to the Police and Firefighter's Retirement Fund (Fund). The five members of the Committee are appointed to staggered, three-year terms. All members of the Police and Firefighter's Retirement Fund are eligible to serve on the Committee.

The Retirement Board, by policy adopted in June 1989, has determined that the Committee will consist of two firefighter positions, two police officer positions, and one management position to be rotated between police and fire every two terms. For these vacancies, the Retirement Board will consider nominations for persons currently serving in a police officer management position and in a firefighter representative position.

Written nominations, which must include background information about the nominee, the nominee's address and a daytime telephone number will be accepted through close of business on June 4, 2007. Please submit nominations to Patti Keyes, Director, Employer and Production Services Division, at 693 West Nye Lane, Carson City, NV 89703. Appointments will be made at the July 2007, Retirement Board meeting. The term of service for those selected to serve on the Committee will expire June 30, 2010.
